## CONTEXT

## CONNECTIONS

Prior Knowledge  
*Link the primary source to other things that you already know  
or have learned about.*

## COMMUNICATION

Point-of-view or bias  
*Is this source reliable?*

## CONCLUSIONS

How does the primary source contribute to our  
understanding of history?

What questions do you have about this source?  
What other source might you need to gain a deeper understandings of  
the topic?
